Circular No. 3/2000 Notice for Builder's Lift - "Overloading Prohibited" Builders' Lifts and Tower Working Platforms (Safety) Ordinance

There was a concern raised in the last liaison meeting by some members of the Builder's Lift and Tower Working Platform Liaison Group regarding the difficulty encountered by the operator in the control of number of passengers in builders' lifts.

To deter passengers from overloading the builder's lift, it was agreed in the meeting that a warning notice shall be displayed in the builder's lift. After several months of consultations with members, the captioned notices (in Chinese and English) with lamination have been prepared. As a responsible registered contractor, you are obliged to liaise with the owners of the builders' lifts under your maintenance to prominently display the said notices inside the lift cages. For the collection of the required numbers of the said notices, please contact Mr. L.C. Wong at 2808 3865.

OVERLOADING PROHIBITED

Pursuant to section 46(5) of the Builders' Lifts and Tower Working Platforms (Safety) Ordinance, any person who wilfully misuses a builder's lift, commits an offence. An offender is liable on conviction to a fine of HK \$50,000 maximum.
